Sue Tompkins pays great attention to the corners, correctly noting that they, more than any other feature of the chart, identify the person, and so traffic to what she calls ascendant and Midheaven complexes needs to be given special attention in interpreting the chart. She persuaded me to look at the corners differently. The author misses aspects between external (trans-Saturnian) planets, doing so, notes that they are formed over long periods of time and tend to reflect world trends rather than things that are felt in the individual. It's a reasonable choice, but this reader would still like to see the author give it a shot, even if in a relatively abbreviated form and perhaps only for those aspects that she herself worked on. External planets, after all, do aspects with each other, and I think it would be good to incorporate them into this comprehensive guide, even if their value in the human chart is not the same as for the inner planets. In addition, the planetoid Chiron is not included, and a growing number of astrologers, including this reviewer, tend to view it as a planet and as a fully paid member of our solar system for the purpose of astrological interpretation, just as we do Pluto. To bring Chiron into the picture, I would highly recommend Melanie Reinhart's Chiron and Healing Journey: Astrological and Psychological Perspective. But overall, it's a great resource for an astrologer, and you could do very well if you relied only on it for interpreting aspects. I think this is an important text and that if you were to have only half a dozen books in your astrology library, this should be one of them. ...
